Population and Housing Census 2011

Population and Housing Census is considered the oldest type of statistic. It has been realized in our territory since the Middle Ages. It brings irreplaceable information about the state of society, its demographic, social and economic and cultural structures, the households of the population and their housing. The census data serve as a basis and starting point for a correct understanding of the functioning of the society, for forecasting its further development, or for taking qualified opinions on social and economic issues. Many of the data collected in the census are unique and cannot be obtained from other sources to the same extent.

Population and Housing Census is an important source of information for all spheres of life, the public and private sectors, the professional and the general public. The collected data can be used in various areas, such as transport, education, health, or sports and leisure. Thus, the results of the census ultimately affect each of us.

The census results present a demographic, social, national, religious structure of the population in a given area, as well as provide information on the structure of dwellings. Therefore, they can significantly influence and shape decisions of authorities at regional and local level. In addition, such data are often the only statistics at the local level. Data serve as a basis for territorial planning of municipalities, for the development of transport infrastructure or infrastructure of various services such as hospitals, education facilities, social service facilities, offices etc. Finally, the results of the census also represent an important basis for the source of income of municipalities from share taxes, which are based on the number of permanent residents in the municipality.
